Thomas Bauschert studied Electrical Engineering at the Munich University of Technology (TUM), Germany, where he earned the Dipl.-Ing. and Dr.-Ing. degrees in 1990 and 1997, respectively. From 1990 to 1997 he was member of the research staff at the Institute of Communication Networks, Munich University of Technology. From 1997 to 2007 he was with Siemens AG and Nokia Siemens Networks GmbH & Co KG, Munich, Germany, where he was responsible, in various positions, for network planning, strategic product management and innovation and research projects in the fields of high speed networks (ATM, IP, Carrier-grade Ethernet) and mobile networks. His last position at Nokia Siemens Networks was manager of a network technology research team.

In 2007, Thomas Bauschert was appointed full professor and head of the Chair of Communication Networks at the Chemnitz University of Technology. His research interests are architectures of communication networks, network control and management mechanisms, network planning and optimization as well as network economics.
