The proceeds from “Laufend gegen Krebs” will support the following projects:

### Improving exercise opportunities for children, teens, and adults with cancer in the Chemnitz area

Exercise interventions carried out under expert guidance have been proven to reduce the side effects of cancer therapy and



increase the performance and self-confidence of those affected. However, since there are currently just a few specialized exercise programs in the Chemnitz area, the Association for Health Sports and Sports Therapy Chemnitz e. V. aims to establish long-term rehabilitative sports groups for oncology patients in childhood, adolescence, and adulthood. Those affected are also to be individually informed on the topic of sports and cancer. In addition to participating in sports together, the focus will also be on fostering social contacts and mutual exchange among participants.

### Family weekend for young families affected by cancer

The „Sächsische Krebsgesellschaft e. V.“ would like to offer young families affected by cancer the opportunity to take a break from the burden of illness for a weekend, have fun together, strengthen mutual trust and also experience exchanges with other families.



### Community housing project

The project's goal is to create a shared living space for those who are affected by cancer and their relatives in an age-appropriate living environment, to enable them to live independently for as long as possible in a community with other affected people and their relatives. This creates the opportunity for mutual help and support and is meant to help make dealing with cancer easier.
