Surface interactions (condensation, desorption, H-atoms)
Gas phase reactions (radicals, ions, electron-ion, deuteration)
Condensation (formation of hydrocarbons, cluster, nanoparticles)

The scientific program of the symposium "Interstellar Reactions: from Gas phase to Solids" will consist of invited lectures and progress reports. Contributed papers will be presented as posters in two afternoon sessions. A number of hot-topics will be chosen from the abstracts for oral presentation.
