



Interstellar Reactions: from Gas Phase to Solids

Pillnitz, 05.06. – 09.06.2005

General information

Venue, transportation

The conference takes place in the Schloßhotel Pillnitz close to Dresden. As described in detail on the conference home page, Pillnitz can be reached rather easily from the Dresden air port, the railroad station.

Taxi from Dresden Hbf to Pillnitz cost about 20 EUR.

We have organized (with private cars) some transportation from Dresden Hbf (main station) Bhf. Dresden Neustadt (station Neustadt and DD-Flughafen (airport). "Schedules" and meeting places are given on a separate sheet.

Hotel

Most invited speakers stay in this hotel, for other participants we have booked rooms in Hotels nearby (Pillnitzer Elbblick, Goldener Apfel, Pappritzer Hof).

Talks will be presented in the *Fliederhof* hall.

All of rooms in the conference hotel are equipped with ISDN telephone including a notebook connection.



Meals

Breakfast is served separately in the hotels. Lunch and diner is served for all participants in Schloßhotel Pillnitz. For special food requirements please contact directly the hotel reception.

Weather

There will be an overhead projector and a beamer

We will provide two laptops (one with WINDOWS 98, one with WINDOWS XP) so you may present your talk from an USB stick or a CD (note; however, that one often runs into problems with the so-called "ppt-standard" if one uses special features, fonts, etc.)

Poster

There will be 2 poster sessions, odd numbers: Monday, 6 June 2005, even numbers Wednesday, 8 June 2005. If possible, all posters will be displayed during the whole conference.

The size of the poster board is 1,00 x 1,40 m (portrait! available area 0,96 m x 1,38 m, suitable for poster size A0). Use double sided adhesive tape for putting the poster in place.
