

Vice-Rector of Chemnitz University visits UJ

UJ Vice-President, Prof. Dr. Hala Khyami met with the Vice-Rector of Chemnitz University of Technology, Prof. Heinrich Lang in the presence of Deputy Dean of the Faculty of Science, Prof. Dr. Fawaz Khalili and Prof. Deeb Ansawi from the Department of Chemistry at the University.

The two sides examined opportunities for joint cooperation in research areas of mutual interest, particularly related to the Department of Chemistry and other areas, as well as access to grants for graduate students.

Khyami confirmed the university's full willingness to adopt suggestions that serve the interests of students, stressing UJ's permanent pursuit to develop relations with various countries in order to encourage and motivate students and update them with the various techniques and scientific environments.

From his part, Lang expressed his admiration for the University of Jordan and the advanced level it has reached, expressing his willingness to cooperate in joint research in the fields of Chemistry, Biology and Engineering, as well as the possibility of providing the opportunity to view electronic journals and scientific research available at the German university.

Lang will be giving several lectures this week in his field; Advanced Science of Materials, intended to graduate students and faculty members at the Department of Chemistry, he will also meet with whom who have interest in joint research from various university departments.

Chemnitz University is one of the oldest universities in Germany, founded in 1836 at the province of Saxony; it comprises 8 Scientific Faculties and ten thousand students.
