What is Special Session?

A Special Session is a focused session organized around a specific theme within the scope of IWIS.

Each session typically includes:

- 3-6 invited and contributed papers
- Coordinated presentations exploring different aspects of the session theme
- Interactive discussions among participants
- Potential for future collaborative publications or journal special issues

Proposal Requirements

Special Session proposals should include:

1. Session Title (concise and descriptive)

2. Session Organizers (1-3 organizers)

- a) Names, affiliations, email addresses
- b) Brief biographies (max 100 words each)
- c) One organizer designated as primary contact

3. Session Description (max 500 words)

- a) Scientific rationale and motivation
- b) Relevance to IWIS community
- c) Expected impact and contribution to the field

4. Tentative List of Contributors (optional but recommended)

- a) Names and affiliations of potential speakers
- b) Preliminary paper titles (if available)
- c) At least 3-6 potential contributions identified

How to Submit:

1. Prepare your proposal following the requirements above

4. Submit as a single PDF document
