EVENTS: This year's School will include **scientific workshops** (e.g. on sensors) and **panel discussions** with senior and mid-level (CRC) researchers, focusing on **career paths after the PhD** within and outside academia. There will also be sessions to present and further discuss ideas on how and in what form the **research topics** of the CRC can be **continued** (sessions 1 and 4). The PLs will therefore have a more active role than in previous schools.

There will also be **contributions from the CRC's early career researchers** on their time in the CRC, to share their key personal achievements, reflect on what went well and what went wrong, and discuss their plans for the future. A **PhD student roundtable** is also scheduled. The school will thus have a more informal character than in previous years. On Friday afternoon/evening a social event is planned.
