→ Activate your Account

At the beginning of your studies you receive a data record sheet („Datenkontrollblatt“) at the student's office. This sheet contains your matriculation number, personal data, and a **service code**. This code is relevant for activating your account.

→ Changing the Password

You should be the only person knowing your password. Do not write it down anywhere, learn it by heart. Log out or lock your screen when leaving the PC you're working at. In case you think, someone may have gained knowledge about your password, change it as soon as possible.





For many courses you must register in order to participate.



registration might take place

- via e-mail
- during the first class
- via *OPAL*
- as well as for courses, you also register for exams
- check with lecturer when and how you have to register for tests, assignments, exams etc.

Bureaucracy: enrolment

1. register with the city
2. get a German bank account
3. get health Insurance (or its confirmation)
4. pay the semester fee (currently € 295,18)
5. enrollment at the Student Service (Admission Office)
6. Strongly recommended: liability insurance (Haftpflichtversicherung)

Bureaucracy: language requirements

According to Regulations on Enrolment, English-speaking degree programs require a certain level of German language skills after the students' first academic year at TU Chemnitz. Also for German-speaking degree programs you might have to proof a certain level of German language skills during your studies.

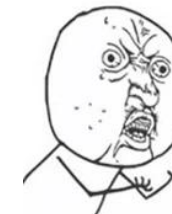
Carefully check the German language requirements applying to your degree program at the beginning of your studies in order to comply with them!

Bureaucracy: Visa and Residence Permit

- citizens from non-EU-countries need a residence permit
- how to get your residence permit:
 1. you will receive an invitation via mail
 2. fill in the form and send it to them, you get an appointment afterwards

Housing off Campus

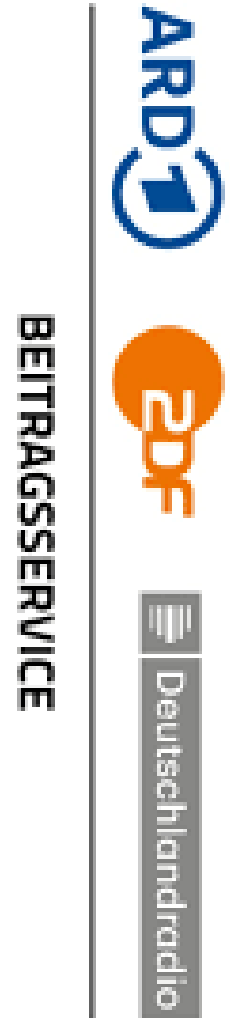
What you should consider and carefully check with your landlord:

- deposit („Kaution“): amount, conditions of refund
- cancellation period of rent contracts (approx. 3 months) and minimum duration
- monthly rent can include:
 - ‚Kaltmiete‘ → rent for the flat/room
 - ‚Warmmiete‘ → additional expenses for water, central heating, waste disposal, etc.
 - + electricity
 - re-calculation and refund OR back payment once a year
 - + Internet/telephone



ARD ZDF Beitragsservice – German Broadcasting Fee (Internet/Radio/TV)

- Funds public broadcasting stations in Germany & secures independence of the media
- is a part of German law („Rundfunkbeitragsstaatsvertrag“)
- every household in Germany has to pay € 18.36 per month independent whether they posses any devices or use them
- possibility of splitting the broadcasting fee within shared apartments
→ therefore it's important to specify the number of your shared flat and your room during registration
- in case problems or questions arise contact the Student Council (internat@stura.tu-chemnitz.de) or Studentenwerk (international@swcz.de)



How to keep your additional expenses to a minimum:

- save water while washing dishes, showering, brushing your teeth
- do not crack the windows open while heating is on – instead open them completely for 5 min
- turn off the heating (or turn it to a minimum) before you leave your flat
- keep the doors in the flat closed and just heat some of the rooms
- do not leave the lights on when you leave the room/flat
- Internet/telephone – check your contract (,flat'-options)



further important information

Please do not ignore any bill.

- If you do not know what you are asked to pay for, ask your landlord, a friend, or students and advisors at TU Chemnitz.
- Any bills should be officially issued, i.e. if you receive bills via SMS, E-Mail, telephone or similar, check whether it is an official bill.

Usually, you do not have to sign a contract/ join an organisation if you do not wish to.

- Especially at the doors of your flat or in the city center you might be asked to donate money, etc. There is no obligation to do so!
