

Chemnitz University of Technology does not charge any tuition fee. However, each student enrolling at TU Chemnitz will have to pay a semester contribution (329.50 Euro as of winter semester 2025/2026). It comprises a contribution to the Student Council, especially for a semester student transportation ticket, as well as a contribution to the Studentenwerk Chemnitz-Zwickau (Student Service Organisation Chemnitz-Zwickau) to draw on its services including cafeterias and canteens as well as social, cultural and sports activities.
