Call for Application "Georgius-Agricola-Scholarships 2026"

Announcement of Georgius-Agricola **Basic Scholarships** on the basis of the funding guidelines of the Saxon State Ministry of Science, Culture and Tourism (SMWK) for study visits by foreign students to universities in the Free State of Saxony dated 10 June 2024.

Purpose of Funding

Funding is provided for foreign students for their whole study in Saxony, Germany in the fields of **mathematics**, **engineering**, **natural sciences and technology**.

Note: Georgius Agricola (1494–1555) was a German humanist scholar and physician, pioneering figures of the early natural sciences. He is the namesake of the scholarship, with **no relation to the term** *agricola* **meaning agriculture**.

Requirements:

- Students are eligible for support starting from their first university semester at Chemnitz University of Technology
- Students are from countries of DAC-list of ODA Recipients: Argentina, Bolivia, Brazil, Ecuador, Guyana, Columbia, Paraguay, Peru, Suriname, Venezuela
- Applicants must demonstrate exceptional talent and potential for outstanding achievements in their studies or future professional career, which may be reflected in academic performance, research activities, or other relevant accomplishments.
- German language skills appropriate to the requirements of the degree program

Funding amount: about 992,00 €/month

Duration: standard period of study

Application deadline: not yet available

The following documents must be submitted:

- Application form, including a personal statement
- Letter of reference of a teacher
- CV (tabular)
- A-level certificate with final grade according to the German grading system
- Current certificate of enrolment of Chemnitz University of Technology (Letter of admission)
- Proof of German language skills



- Copy of passport
- · Residence permit

Please note:

- I. The Scholarship Commission of the International Office awards scholarship holders. Selection criteria include the stated above; they are in line with the requirements detailed by the SMWK.
- II. The scholarship is granted only for studies at Chemnitz University of Technology and is paid out from the beginning of the stay.
- III. Scholarship holders must immediately inform the International Office about absences and possible sources of additional income, e.g. other scholarships or wages/salary.
- IV. Applicants have no legal claim to a scholarship. Scholarships may only be awarded under reservation of resourcing by the SMWK and are subject to approval of the International Office Scholarship Commission.
- V. Only complete applications, received at due date at the International Office, will be considered.
