

Tender of scholarship within the program "TU4Ukraine - Future Ukraine Scholarship Program for Refugees from Ukraine at German Universities" of the German Academic Exchange Service for Bachelor, Master and PhD students

The German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) provides TU Chemnitz with financial means in order to support international students with scholarships in 2023 and 2024. Eligible are undergraduate students (Diploma, Magister, and Bachelor) as well as graduate students (Master) and PhD-students. Students must be regularly enrolled at TU Chemnitz in order to obtain one of the degrees mentioned.

Monthly award:	max. 934,00 € (Bachelor and Master students) max. 1.300,00 € (Doctoral students) (possible deductions due to additional income)
Duration:	up to 9 months with the option of extension
Start:	April 2024
Application deadline:	19 April 2024

Funding is provided for the professional qualification of particularly high-achieving students who have fled to Germany as well as future academics from Ukraine at German universities or with study periods at universities in both countries.

The scholarships can be awarded to the following groups of people:

- Ukrainian citizens who had their residential center in Ukraine until 24 February 2022 and/or who have been in Germany as exchange students since the winter semester 2021/22, were unable to return due to the war and are now seeking a degree in Germany
- Third-country nationals or stateless persons granted international protection in Ukraine if they have resided in Ukraine before or on 24 February 2022
- Third-country nationals who have resided in Ukraine with a permanent residence permit before or on 24 February 2022 and cannot safely return to their country of origin

Please note:

- I. The Scholarship Commission of the International Office awards scholarship holders. Selection criteria include the stated above; they are in line with the requirements detailed by the DAAD.
- II. Eligible are only students enrolled at TU Chemnitz.
- III. Scholarship holders must immediately inform the International Office about absences and possible sources of additional income, e.g. other scholarships or wages/salary.
- IV. Applicants have no legal claim to a scholarship. Scholarships may only be awarded under reservation of resourcing by the DAAD and are subject to approval of the International Office Scholarship Commission.

Applications include:

1. Duly filled and signed application form, including a personal statement
2. CV (tabular)
3. Latest Transcript of Records, for PhD-students: Copy of Masters Certificate
4. Proof of German language skills (if available)
5. Copy of passport and residence permit or certificate of fiction
6. Current certificate of enrollment or copy of the admission letter
