

Information for refugees on the application process at Chemnitz University of Technology

Choose a degree program and check the requirements

Apply via *uni-assist* to check the comparability of your degree For winter semester: until 15 July | For summer semester: until 15 January

- 1. Submission of requested documents to uni-assist
- 2. If comparability is ensured, the application documents will be forwarded to Chemnitz University of Technology

Checking of documents by the Student Service Point of Chemnitz University of Technology

Fulfillment of all requirements: Issuing of admission letter

Language Requirements

- German as language of instruction: proof of German language proficiency of C1 according to the Common Framework of Reference for Languages
- English as language of instruction: proof of German language proficiency of A1*, and additionally English language proficiency of B2 according to the Common Framework of References for Languages

DSH-Language Course (C1)

- 3 months intensive course for € 1,500
- requirements: German language proficiency of B2, fulfillment of the academic requirements for enrollment at Chemnitz University of Technology

Semester Fee

- currently (status as of 2019): € 264.59
- includes: free public transport in Chemnitz and trains in Saxony, access to Mensa, university libraries, free entrance to the theatres of Chemnitz and selected museums ("Kulturticket")
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$ the fee must be paid completely before enrollment
- * A1 needed at the time of application until the end of the third study term at Chemnitz University of Technology you must have achieved A2. There are only a few exceptions for some master programs.

Get started!

Even after having obtained your admission letter, the program "Welcome to TU Chemnitz" helps you with words and deeds. We offer a tandem program, where students of our university help refugees to get started at Chemnitz University of Technology and to understand the requirements for enrollment. Furthermore, we will organize events and trips in Chemnitz in cooperation with the Student Buddy Programm.
