Going to Authorities

Arrival in Saxony without private accommodation

If you do not have a private accommodation in Chemnitz yet, you must go to the reception center of the state of Saxony:

Aufnahmeeinrichtung Mockau II Graf-Zeppelin-Ring 15 04356 Leipzig

Arrival in Chemnitz with private accommodation

Welcome to the European Capital of Culture 2025! Now you have to go to some authorities.

1. Residents' Registration Office

Please register with the city of Chemnitz.



2. Foreigners' Registration Office (applying for § 24 AufenthG)

In order to apply for a residence permit under § 24 AufenthG (Residence Act) you need to submit a form to the Foreigners' Registration Office.



3. Support by the State

With your residence permit you can obtain state benefits. The responsible authority for this is the Jobcenter.





Steps Towards Studying at TU Chemnitz

As a refugee interested in studying, you can choose between a degree program and an exchange stay.

Taking up a degree program

The application must be done via uni-assist.

Prospective students from Ukraine who just have finished the 11th grade must attend a Studienkolleg (preparatory college) beforehand. The preparatory college prepares students for studies at a German university. TU Chemnitz works together with the Studienkolleg Sachsen in Leipzig.



Exchange stay

An exchange stay is a temporary bridging measure until the resumption of the regular studies. If you are interested, please contact the International Office for further information.

Guest Audition

If you are still unsure what you want to study, you can try the guest audition program first. The guest audition is free of charge for students from Ukraine. However, please note the following:



- you do not obtain the semester ticket and
- you are not allowed to take exams.

Admission

If all formal and academic requirements are fulfilled, you will receive an admission letter. On this letter you will find all information about the enrollment.
