## Institutional Nomination

Procedure	<p>The International Office of the institution of origin must complete the UdeC nomination form, detailing information on students candidates who will pursue exchange studies at UdeC.</p> <p>After being determined eligible, the students will be responsible for completing their applications.</p> <p>The required documents are attached.</p> <p><i>(See student's application)</i></p>
Deadline for nomination	<p><b>First Semester:</b> from September 1st to October 15th</p> <p><b>Second Semester:</b> from April 1st to May 15th</p>
Nomination deadline for all the programs of the Medical School	<p><b>First Semester:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• First call: from August 15th to September 15th</li> <li>• Second call: from October 1st to October 15th</li> </ul> <p><b>Second Semester:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• First call: from December 1st to January 5th</li> <li>• Second call: from April 1st to May 15th</li> </ul>

## Student Application

Procedure	<p>Once the request for nomination has been approved, the nominated students and institutional authorities for exchange studies will receive an email from the account: <a href="mailto:exchange@udec.cl">exchange@udec.cl</a> with the instructions for accessing the UdeC Application Platform, a virtual site where the students can enter information regarding:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Required Documents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Updated university transcripts in English or Spanish</li> <li>• Cover letter expressing interest in exchange studies</li> <li>• Brief Curriculum Vitae or resume</li> <li>• Certificate B1 in Spanish (Certificado Instituto Cervantes/Certificado Servicio Internacional de Evaluación de la Lengua Española (SIELE)/Accreditation of level reached at Institution of origin)</li> <li>• Copy of Passport (optional at the time of application, but document is mandatory to obtain a letter of acceptance from UdeC)</li> </ul>
Deadline for application	<p><b>First Semester:</b> October 30th</p> <p><b>Second Semester:</b> May 30th</p>
Application deadline for all the programs of the Medical School	<p><b>First Semester:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• First call: October 15th</li> <li>• Second call: October 30th</li> </ul> <p><b>Second Semester:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• First call: January 20th</li> <li>• Second call: May 30th</li> </ul>
