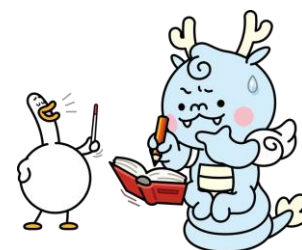


Visa Type

Visa Requirements	All students must obtain a Student Visa (D-2) All students must complete Alien Registration within 90 days of entering Korea.
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Course and Evaluation

Class Hours	※ Most classes at Inha comprise of 3 hours per week, which means that they are designed as three (3)-credit courses. 1 credit hour equals 15 class hours with the exception of experimental courses being 30 hours.
Subjects not taught in English	Korean Language & Culture(KLC), Korean Language & Literature(KLL), Architecture, College of Education, Fashion Design, Theatre Studies, Fine Arts, and etc. (Refer to English course list) ※ Applicant's applying major can be rejected or altered depending on the availability of English courses.
Not allowed to apply	Nursing, Medicine
Korean language courses	Basic Korean / Intermediate Korean/ Cheerful Inha Korean for Exchange Students
Average Course Load per Semester	Undergraduate: 12 ~ 19 Inha credits
	Graduate: 3~9 Inha credits
	*Graduate exchange students cannot take undergraduate courses and vice versa.





Insurance

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'Private insurance & Korean National Health Insurance (NHIS)' are mandatory for all students. It is government regulation with no exception.

Private insurance: will be purchased first week of school

NHIS: will automatically qualified

※ Even if you already have health insurance at your home university, you must purchase a designated private health insurance at Inha university according to government regulations.

Accommodation and Housing Assistance (It can be subject to change for 2027 Spring)

1. On-Campus Dormitory

Dormitory Fees (as of Spring 2027):

Approximately KRW 1,500,000 per semester (including one meal per day)

Room Type: Quadruple rooms with shared bathroom facilities

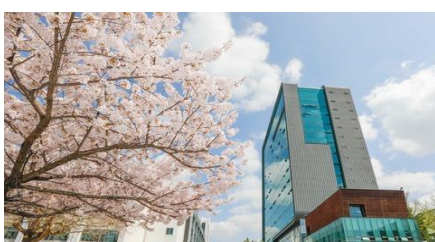
Payment: Payment must be made online prior to arrival.

※ A penalty of KRW 100,000 will be imposed for cancellations made within 30 days prior to the check-in date.

※ Dormitory fees are subject to change each semester.

※ Check-in will not be permitted without a copy of a valid Tuberculosis (TB) test result.

2. Off-Campus Housing Introduced by INHA

Off-Campus Housing Fees (as of Spring 2027):

Approximately KRW 700,000 per month

※ A penalty of KRW 100,000 will be imposed for cancellations made within 30 days prior to the check-in date.

※ The International Center provides assistance for students who wish to stay in studio-type (one-room) accommodations near campus.

※ The International Center cannot assist with off-campus housing options other than those mentioned above. Students who wish to find shared apartments must do so independently, preferably upon early arrival.

※ Off-campus housing fees are subject to change each semester.

Note

More detailed information regarding costs and payment procedures will be sent to you by email in early January (for students studying at Inha University in the Spring semester) or in early July (for students studying at Inha University in the Fall semester).

Students whose mobile devices do not support NFC functionality or are not based on Android or iOS are strongly advised not to apply for dormitory housing, as the university application must be installed for dormitory access, and usage may be restricted on unsupported devices.

※ Students who wish to apply for the Buddy Program should select the appropriate checkbox when applying for the exchange program through the online application system.

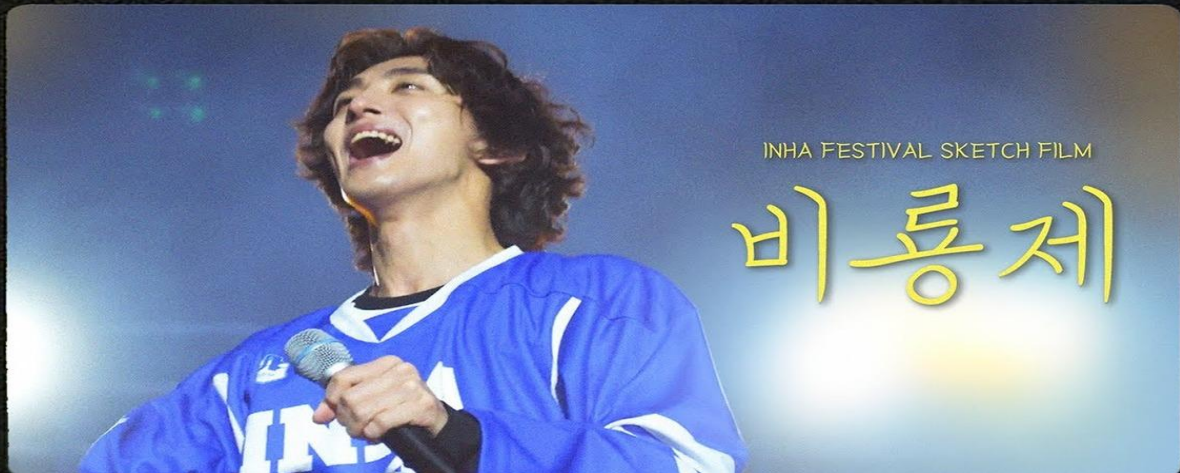
Personal illness and medicines	Students are responsible for managing their own health and personal illnesses. If students plan to bring medications from their home country to Korea, they must check in advance whether the medications are permitted by the Korean Ministry of Food and Drug Safety (MFDS) (https://www.mfds.go.kr/eng/index.do). If required, students must complete the necessary procedures to obtain prior approval for carrying such medications in accordance with MFDS regulations.
Estimated Living Expense	KRW 1,300,000 per month (Including accommodation and meals; applicable if not staying in the University Dormitory) KRW 150,000 per month for miscellaneous expenses (Including transportation, textbooks, etc.)



Student card	Physical student ID cards will not be provided to students. The university application is available only for Android or iOS users. The application is required for access to campus facilities, including dormitories and libraries. Students are strongly recommended to possess a compatible device whenever possible.
