About our courses:

Typical credit load per course:

3 or 4 PUCP credits

Required course load for international students

Depends on home institution.

Grading system

From 0 to 20.

11 is the minimum pass mark.

How does our credit system work?

At PUCP, each course has a value expressed in credits. One PUCP credit is equivalent to one hour of taught classes a week throughout the semester, or at least two hours a week of practical classes. Each semester lasts 17 weeks (lectures and exams). Students have to consider that attendance is mandatory.

Our credit system only contemplates lecturing hours, not time doing homework, preparing for exams nor studying independently. So, hours of work out of class are not included in PUCP credits. Therefore, we recommend our students to check all the syllabus and send it to their coordinator at university of origin to check the workload of each course.

Our recommendation for exchange students is to take between 12 and 15 PUCP credits, despite the program they are currently enroll.



Language of instruction

Most of our courses are in Spanish. We have a limited list of courses in English, but it is updated each semester with different courses. We'll provide this list as soon as it is confirmed by each school.

Students need a B2 level. We won't ask for any proof of language certification.

Keep in mind that...

- International students are allow to enroll in courses from different schools and levels, if places are available. The list of courses will be published around 3 weeks before each semester starts.
- Each school makes an effort to accommodate exchange students in their classes, but due to overcrowding and equipment constraints in some majors, they cannot always give students the courses they choose.
- Courses from CENTRUM, thesis and some seminars are not available.
- We don't offer a Spanish language course. Our Language Center "Idiomas Católica" offers Spanish, Portuguese and English for beginners (with no credits). For fee info, write to idiomas@pucp.edu.pe

Partner universities nominate their students online. We send them our registration form.

Students can save a draft of the application and access it by logging on again later to complete the application. They can upload the required supporting documents online.

Mandatory Health Insurance

It is mandatory for all international students to be covered by an international health insurance plan that complies with medical expenses and evacuation in case of sickness/accident, repatriation of remains and guarantee of direct payment. Also, they must send a list of private hospitals in Lima, confirmed by their insurance company, where they have coverage.

If the original document is not issue in English or Spanish, students are allow to make a translation on their own. They have to submit both documents during application

Students who don't send both documents won't be able to be enrolled and study with us.



Visa requirements

Foreign students change their immigration status from tourist to student once they are in Peru. As a tourist, they get a permit to stay for up to 90 days when they arrive. During that time, they start to apply to get their student status for 180 days or 1 year.

Frequent questions:

Is it possible to do an exchange for more than one year?

No, you can only apply for 1 semester or 1 academic year.

During our exchange, are we able to do an internship?

No, internships are not available for international students. Remember, you have a student status.

Are fees applicable to exchange students?

No, there aren't any fees.

Does PUCP accept graduate students?

Yes, but they must be enrolled in a posgraduate program on their university of origin to apply.

Are international students allow to work?

No, you are not allow to do it while you are doing your exchange. Remember, you have a student status.

Do you offer on-campus housing?

No, we provide assistance in finding off-campus housing. A list of student residences and family houses will be sent after students completed their application.
