Health Exam

All exchange students are required to submit Health certificate in English or Chinese. Please be noted that it only valid for 3 months, so please make sure that it is not expired before your arrival in NCUE and hand in to OICA after your arrival.

Insurances

Medical and injury insurance which covers the entire exchange period is required. We strongly recommend you to purchase your own travel insurance before arriving in Taiwan and provide OICA with the related documents on the registration day. Who couldn't provide the certificate, will be asked to sign the Declaration of Insurance and join the Group Foreign Students Health Insurance which is provided by Mercuries Life insurance company and costs NT\$ 3,000 for 5 months.

Exchange Program Application Procedure

Applicants should contact home university for nomination. Home university should nominates students via email to NCUE before nomination deadline. Fall semester: By early June Spring semester: By mid-November Applicants fill out the application form and scan all the required documents on the checklist. Home university send all the application documents to NCUE before application deadline. Fall semester: By mid-June Spring semester: By Late November NCUE will assess your application based upon application documentation. NCUE will announce the admission status after screening via email to home university. Fall semester: By early July Spring semester: By late December Exchange students start apply for a visa. Do health exam and submit the Health Certificate to NCUE. Fall semester: By early August Spring semester: By early January NCUE will send pre-choose course list and pre-departure email to all exchange students. Fall semester: By early August Spring semester: By early January Provide Flight schedule to NCUE for pick-up service. Fall semester: By Late August Spring semester: By Late January See you at NCUE!
