General Steps for University Coordinators	The nominated students will receive an email with a registration link after our International Office has verified the nomination.
	Please note that the system service is only available during the nomination/application period.
	Step 1. Online Application: Students receive a notification email for the Online Application and must fill in the required information after being nominated.
General Steps for Students	Step 2. NKUST Review: After students complete the application and upload the required documents. NKUST departments and the Office of International Affairs (OIA) will begin reviewing the applications.
	Step 3. Result Announcement: After the review process is completed, the results will be announced via the online system; students are requested to log in to their accounts to check them.

Step 4. Download the Letter of Acceptance: If students are accepted and pass the application review, they will have to fill in the final check for enrollment and download the Letter of Acceptance on their **own application result page**.

Step 5. Submission of Post-Acceptance Documents: After completing Step 4, we will send a Google form to students to complete the required information upon arrival before the new semester begins.

Visitor Visa	\$1,600	Incoming exchange students are required to apply for a Visitor Visa to enter Taiwan. If the duration of stay on your visa does not cover your full exchange or visiting period, you will need to apply for a Visitor Visa Extension. Please note that overstaying your visa can result in fines. For extension details, please consult the National Immigration Agency .
Alien Residence Certificate (ARC)-One-year exchange students	\$2,200	Compulsory for foreign exchange students stay for a full academic year, it is required to apply for an Alien Resident Certificate (ARC) within 30 days after their arrival.

Insurance

International Medical Insurance	Depends on your country's medical programs	Exchange students are required to purchase the International Medical Insurance. Alternatively, students may obtain medical insurance in their home country and submit proof of coverage upon arrival. The period of insurance should cover the date of your arrival until the date you leave.

Accommodation Information

On-Campus housing

- Exchange students are eligible to apply for on-campus accommodation at the campus where their department is located.
- It is required to submit the <u>dormitory application</u> online, with the application date to be announced after acceptance. **Applications submitted after the deadline will not be accepted.**

- Bedding is not provided; students are required to bring their own, including a mattress, pillow, quilt, and personal toiletries, or to buy them in Taiwan.
- Air conditioning in campus dormitories is charged separately, with residents required to purchase air conditioning cards to cover electricity costs.
- Dormitory fees must be paid before the start of the semester by downloading the payment slip from the NKUST student portal.

Health Examination

To meet the requirements of the Taiwan government, all new exchange students must complete a health examination before arriving in Taiwan. The exam must be conducted by a qualified doctor in your home country, and the following forms must be completed:

- For students staying less than 6 months: "Health Certificate for Short-Term Students"
- For students staying more than 6 months: Health Certificate for Residence Application"

■ Reminder

- For the actual amount of payment, please refer to the payment slip issued by the NKUST after registration.
- Students who already have a Chinese name or a preferred Chinese name are required to provide it at the time of application. Otherwise, the name that is assigned by NKUST cannot be changed after being assigned.
