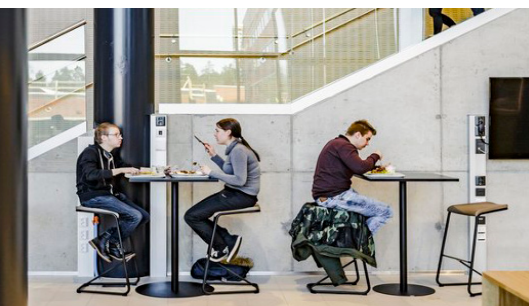

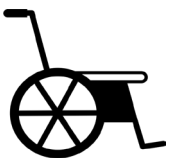
ESTIMATED LIVING COSTS
