Course enrolment cannot be guaranteed before arrival as it may be subject to the limitations imposed by timetable constraints or unexpected course cancellations. Even if courses are lectured in different Faculties enrolment is to be done in the Faculty which your University set the Erasmus agreement with. Enrolment is to be done after arrival according with the dates set in the academic calendar and/or with the enrolment guidelines of the appropriate
