FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Do I need to speak French to apply?

No, you don't need to speak French to apply, but a B2 certificate is required by May. To help you feel more comfortable in France and in Nancy, we offer a French Summer School before the start of the academic year.

My school doesn't have an agreement with Mines Nancy. Can I still apply?

Yes, GREENANO accepts free-moving candidates, and we can discuss partnerships with your university if needed.

How do I find accommodation in Nancy?

Mines Nancy helps with housing, visa, and insurance. Rooms in CROUS residences cost from €240/month.

Do I need a visa?

Most students require a VLS-TS (long-stay visa). Apply online and validate it within 3 months after arrival.

What if I get sick when I'm in France?

Social Security reimburses 70% of medical costs. EU students with a European Health Insurance Card don't need extra coverage.

What are monthly expenses in Nancy?

Living in Nancy is affordable, with average monthly expenses starting from €600. This includes student residence costs (€240-€440), food (€300), transport (€30-€50), and plenty of budget-friendly entertainment options.

HOW TO APPLY

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Exchange and Double-Degree Programs

- At least 7 completed semesters of higher education
- Excellent academic results, especially in Math and Physics
- B1-B2 level of French proficiency

GREENANO Master

- Bachelor's degree (or recognized equivalent) in Physics, Materials Science, Engineering, Nanoscience
- Excellent academic results
- B2-C2 level of English proficiency

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

1 Your home university may need to nominate you (for example, for BRAFITEC program) while some applicants may need to apply directly.

Nomination periods:

- 16 Feb -30 March (double degree and fall semester)
- 14 Sep -30 October (spring semester)

2 The application documents should be submitted via E-Candidate platform: www.ecandidat.univ-lorraine.fr

- Official transcripts (in English, French, Portuguese)
- CV and cover letter
- Copy of passport
- Proof of Language Proficiency (recommended)

3 Your application will be evaluated by the Jury. If successful, you will receive an Admission Letter. However, for some students (for example, nominated through BRAFITEC program), acceptance is automatic upon nomination, and they will receive their admission letters directly.

1 The online application form and the following application documents should be submitted on the program website: www.greenanomaster.eu

- CV and cover letter
- Copy of passport
- Proof of Language Proficiency
- Two recommendation letters

2 The shortlisted applicants will be invited to an online interview with the Admission Committee.

3 The selected applicants will receive the Admission Letters upon successful interview results.
