APPLICATIONS

Nomination deadlines:

First term: May 15th

Second term: October 15th

Application deadlines (university enrollment and housing):

First term: June 1st

Second term: November 1st

Language requirements:

Test of knowledge in French (B2 or C1 depending on the program) or a letter of a French teacher giving evidence of an equivalent level. For programs in another language, the test depends on the chosen program.

LEARNING FRENCH

UMLP hosts the Center for Applied Linguistics (CLA), a world-renowned center of expertise in the fields of language teaching, curriculum design and research, especially for French as a Foreign Language (FLE). Whether you are a student, a French teacher or willing to learn French, different programs are available from one week trainings to an entire academic year. CLA offers cultural activities, personalized and comprehensive support as well as internships in elementary and secondary schools in the district.



STUDY AT UMLP

Academic year

First semester starts in early September and ends in early December before the Christmas break – the dates depend of the department you applied for.

Second semester starts in early January and ends in early May – the dates depend of the department you applied for.

Semester 1 exams take place in early to mid-January.
Semester 2 exams take place in mid or late-May.

Resit exams session

A resit session is organised in June for students who need to retake exams.
