<i>Language requirements</i>	Exchange students should have at least a B1 level of French following the Common Framework of Reference for Languages (CECRL): see the webpage for International students mentioned above. 18 international Masters are taught in English. Beware: access to these Masters is restricted. http://www.grenoble-inp.fr/en/academics
<i>Deadline for applications</i>	Fall semester : March 1 st – April 30 th Spring semester : September 16 th – November 12 th
<i>General notes</i>	Graduate courses are open to exchange students (1 st and 2 nd year of engineering school) based on their education and their prerequisites.
<i>Academic year</i>	Fall semester: From September 2 nd 2019 to January 24 th 2020 (but some dates can change according the School or the Program) Spring semester: From January 27 th to July 3 rd 2020 (but some dates can change according the School or the Program)
<i>Exams</i>	Last 2 weeks of January for Fall semester Between mid-May to mid-June for Spring semester exams
