Accommodation	<p>There are lots of renting possibilities here in Huelva for most budgets ranging from students rooms in residence halls to shared flats, so no need to worry in this sense.</p> <p>For your convenience, we recommend renting a flat in the city center or near the Campus El Carmen (Los Rosales, Fuentepiña, Avenida Andalucía,...).</p> <p>You have two options when searching for a flat in Huelva:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Temporary accommodation for the first days while looking for a permanent flat or room. 2. What is the average cost of accommodation per month?	Usually between 180€ - 230€ per student per month in shared flat with own bedroom (bills included).
