Language Requirements	<p>The Institute of French as a Foreign Language (i-FLE) accepts beginners in their program.</p> <p>Students not planning on enrolling at i-FLE are asked to provide proof of proficiency in French attested by either the French department at their home university or by an official French language test/certificate (DELF, DALF, TCF) with the student's level of proficiency.</p> <p>In order to ensure that students complete their coursework successfully, a minimum level of B1 as defined by the Council of Europe is required to study abroad at the Université de Nantes. Some departments expect students to have a B2 level or higher.</p> <p>Since French embassies and consulates are now increasingly demanding proof of proficiency in French, students will need to verify the requirements applying to their home country.</p>
French Support Classes for Exchange Students	<p>These classes are offered free of charge for exchange students and take place twice a week during the evening, usually from 6pm to 8pm.</p> <p>Students wishing to take the French support classes must request them while filling out the online application.</p> <p>French support classes aren't available for students enrolled in French semester courses at i-FLE.</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">Is on-campus housing available for exchange students?</p>	<p>Yes, university housing is available for exchange students only. However, the number of rooms being limited, we cannot guarantee to meet all accommodation requests.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">If yes, how do students request on-campus housing?</p>	<p><u>Students from partner institutions who wish to request on-campus housing can do so while filling out the online application form.</u></p> <p>Students should apply early in order to increase their chances of being placed in a residence hall.</p> <p>For more information about housing in university residences, please download the Housing document on our website: <i>Etudier/Se former > Incoming students: venir étudier à Nantes > English Version > Incoming Exchange students / More information about the application procedure > Non-European Exchanges/European exchanges</i></p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Are residence halls open during semester breaks?</p>	<p>Yes, university residences are open for the entire academic year (September-May) including all school breaks between September and May. There are no additional housing fees during the breaks.</p> <p>Shall students need to extend their stay during the summer (June, July, and August) for academic reasons; they can contact the staff at the International Relations Office for further information.</p>

VISA AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

<p>Are exchange students required to obtain a student visa?</p>	<p>Students planning to study abroad must contact the French consulate or Campus France services in their country of residence at least 3 months before their departure in order to find out about visa requirements.</p> <p>Generally, if the student's mobility period in France lasts more than three months, he/she must obtain a long-term student visa before the arrival in France.</p> <p>Citizens from the European Union, the European Economic Area, Andorra, Monaco, San Marino, Switzerland, and the Vatican are not required to obtain a visa to study in France.</p> <p><u>Foreigners residing in any of the previously mentioned territories are allowed to stay a maximum of 90 days in France.</u> Therefore, they must obtain a visa before coming to France.</p> <p><u>Students who are part of the ERASMUS+ program but who are not citizens of one of the above mentioned entities must obtain a visa.</u></p>
<p>Are exchange students allowed to work?</p>	<p>The type of visa that students obtain before their arrival in France determines whether or not they are allowed to work. Students who are allowed to work in France must get their residence permit before starting to work.</p> <p>Foreign students are only allowed to work 964 hours per year (approximately 20 - 21 hours per week) with the exception of academic holidays when they are allowed to work full time.</p>

<p>French Health Coverage <i>Sécurité Sociale</i> (CPAM)</p>	<p>All European Union students must have their European Health Insurance Card.</p> <p>Non-European students will be asked to register online for the National Health Service Coverage using the following website: etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr</p> <p>For further information about Health coverage and health services, please see our website: Etudier/Se former > Incoming students: venir étudier à Nantes > English Version > International Student Guide > Health coverage and health services</p>
<p>Do exchange students need to take out any other insurance plans upon arrival?</p>	<p>Yes, students must purchase a <u>French housing insurance</u> when they arrive to Nantes. This insurance is mandatory in order to move into their living quarters.</p> <p><u>Civil liability insurance</u> is also mandatory for all exchange students.</p> <p>Housing and civil liability insurances can be purchased as a package online. Further information will be provided by the International Relations Office once the mobility period is confirmed.</p>

Medical services on campus	<p>Every student enrolled at Université de Nantes has free access to the University's health services: Service santé - social étudiant - SUMPPS. CVEC - Student and Campus Life Contribution	<p>Exchange students are exempted of this contribution. However, there are some exceptions.
