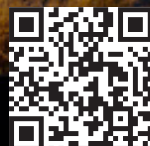

NOTE:

- It is not possible to combine courses from the different exchange programs or campuses.
- Not all exchange programs are offered in each semester.

NOMINATION PROCEDURE

Online nomination form - link sent by email twice a year.

Nomination deadlines:

Fall semester (September - January) / Academic year

NOTE: we have 2 nomination deadlines for Fall:

- 15 March (all programs except those listed below)
- 15 April (Business, Communication, Education)

Spring semester (February - July) / Calendar year:

- 15 September

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

After nomination, students receive a link to our online application form.

Documents to be uploaded with or after their application:

- Official transcript of records
- Short motivation
- Color photograph
- Copy of valid passport or ID document

Application deadlines:

Fall semester / Academic year:

- 15 May

Spring semester / Calendar year:

- 15 October

ACCOMMODATION

HAN facilitates furnished, off-campus accommodation for its exchange students.

Students indicate on the online Exchange Application Form whether they wish to apply for university facilitated accommodation. HAN Housing Office then sends them application instructions.

Note: only available to students under 31 years of age!

Depending on their nationality and length of stay, students may require an entry visa and/or residence permit. For a stay exceeding 3 months, HAN applies for these on behalf of the student.

GRADING SCALE

The Dutch grading scale is from 1 (very poor) to 10 (outstanding).

The lowest passing grade is 6.

A grade of 9 is seldom given and a 10 is extremely rare.

The grades 1 - 3 are hardly ever used.

In some cases no grade is given, but only a "pass".

The Boards of Examiners at HAN do not permit students, who have studied at a partner university, to write long distance exams offered by the host university once they have returned to HAN.
