Spectral theory of compact operators on Hilbert spaces. Reproducing kernel Hilbert spaces (RKHS). Objectives of the course: The students learn basic concepts of classical Hilbert space theory. In addition, they will become sensitive for the analogies and differences to the (finite dimensional) linear algebra.
