3rd Colloquium innoTRAC — Innovative Traction Mechanisms

On **18th and 19th September 2024**, the third international colloquium "**innoTRAC**" will take place at the Chemnitz University of Technology. We, the Professorship of Conveying Engineering and Materials Handling of the Chemnitz University of Technology and the Chair of Material Handling of the TU Dresden, invite all interested parties to a professional exchange in the following subject areas:

- **Traction and load-bearing mechanisms in application and development**
 - Fiber, wire and hybrid ropes
 - Toothed belts, belts and straps
 - Chains made of plastic, steel round links and steel links
- **Drive systems for traction mechanisms**
- **Test methods and rapid testing**
- **Condition monitoring and data acquisition**

Research, development and application of traction and load-bearing mechanisms for conveyor systems, hoisting devices and elevators are the focus of the colloquium. However, bridges should be built between different fields. Cross-sectional topics such as **hybrid systems**, **recycling** and **tribology** are also included. Breaks and the evening event will provide opportunities for discussion and networking.

The colloquium is held as face-to-face event as well as online in German and English. You are invited to present your current projects and research results. Submit an abstract on your subject at www.innotrac.de. We are looking forward to your contributions.
