



What would you study in the BA Programme?

Students of English and American Studies are engaged in studying the literatures, languages, cultures and media of the entire English-speaking world (from Canada to Australia). An essential part of the course programme is to gain communicative and work-related skills in the target language English. Based on the wide range of courses offered, various academic perspectives will be explored: English Literatures, English Linguistics as well as British and American Cultural and Social Studies. A compulsory semester abroad promotes the international orientation and intercultural skills of our students.

Degree Structure

The study programme consists of three foundation modules, six core modules, advanced and complementary modules as well as the Bachelor Thesis. A compulsory semester abroad (or foreign-oriented semester) supports intercultural and practical language skills. The modularization allows for a combination of major subjects with complementary modules, according to personal preferences and academic interests.

Foundation Modules (1st-6th semester)

- English Language Training: Basics
- English Language Training: Skills
- Professional Skills

Core Modules (1st-4th semester)

- English Language and Culture
- Applied Linguistics
- English Literatures and Cultures I
- English Literatures and Cultures II
- British Social and Cultural Studies
- American Social and Cultural Studies

Semester Abroad or Foreign-oriented Semester (5th semester)

Complementary Modules (2nd-4th semester)

One of the following modules must be selected:

- Media Communication
- German Studies
- Foreign Language (A1-B1)
- Political Science
- Basics of Educational Studies

Advanced Modules (4th/6th semester)

One of the following modules must be selected:

- Advanced English Language and Culture
- Advanced English Literatures and Cultures
- Advanced British and American Social and Cultural Studies

Module Bachelor Thesis (Students write their BA thesis in their area of specialization while attending the final semester's classes for that module)
