Reading by Henry Beissel: Canadian Poet, Dramatist, Translator and Critic

Henry Beissel, born on 12 April 1929 in Cologne, and widely regarded as a major representative of modern Canadian literature, will read from a selection of his poetry collections, including Cantos North (1982), which has been described as a Canadian epic, Coming to Terms with Childhood (2011), a commemorative poem about his childhood in Nazi Germany, and Seasons of Blood, a meditation on nature, science and history, which he regards as his magnum opus.
