Content and Goals of the Qualification	<p><u>Content:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Expanding and practising vocabulary and improving speaking skills - Tasks in communicative situations with reference to time and wasting time, free-time activities, daily routines, studies, work and professional life as well as modern media - Revision and consolidation of basic grammatical structures as well as imparting further grammatical structures including passive voice and subordinate clauses <p>The training is oriented to the B1 language level in the CEF (Common European Framework).</p> <p><u>Goals:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Improvement in speaking skills, simple as well as coherent expression referring to familiar topics - Reporting experiences and events, describing goals and plans, giving reasons and explanations - Communication based on simple language - Comprehension and writing of texts referring to every-day topics <p>Completion of the module corresponds to the B1 language level in the CEF (Common European Framework).</p>

Prerequisites for Granting Credit Points	Successful passing of the module test is the prerequisite for granting credit points.
Module Test	<p>A module test consists of a test in which the following is accredited:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a 90-minute test for Kurs 3 <p>The student performance is granted credits if the mark of at least "sufficient" is reached.</p>
Credit Points and Grades / Marks	4 credit points are granted for the module. The evaluation of the test performance and the mark follow the guidelines set in §10 of the testing guidelines (Prüfungsordnung).
Frequency of the Offer	The module is offered every semester.
Amount of Work	The expected amount of work for a student to complete this module is 120 hours of work (60 hours in class and 60 hours of self-study).
