Content and Goals of the Qualification	<p><u>Content:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Imparting basic knowledge of the German language (lexis, grammar, phonetics) - Introducing and practising vocabulary referring to simple topics such as family, shopping and living - Learning first grammatical structures and rules including articles, the declension of nouns, modal verbs, the negative, present and perfect tense forms - Phonetics exercises <p>The training is oriented to the A1 language level in the CEF (Common European Framework).</p> <p><u>Goals:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Comprehension of familiar expressions and simple sentences in every-day life situations - Communication referring to simple expressions and sentences - Answering simple questions referring to personal details and family as well as education and studies <p>Completion of this module corresponds to the A1 language level in the CEF (Common European Framework).</p>

Prerequisites for Granting Credit Points	Successful passing of the module test is the prerequisite for granting credit points.
Module Test	<p>A module test consists of a test in which the following is accredited:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a 90-minute written test for Kurs 1 <p>The student performance is granted credits if the mark of at least "sufficient" is reached.</p>
Credit Points and Grades/Marks	4 credit points are granted for the module. The evaluation of the test performance and the mark follow the guidelines set in §10 of the testing guidelines (Prüfungsordnung).
Frequency of the Offer	The module is offered every semester.
Amount of Work	The expected amount of time for a student to complete this module is 120 hours of work (60 hours in class and 60 hours of self-study).
