<b>Content and Goals of the Qualification</b>	<p><u>Content:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Dealing with topics related to social sciences and in addition to cultural studies in general as well as of the German-speaking world specifically, imparting and training the fundamentals of academic and scientific text production</li> <li>- Independent production and presentation of a study project including the formulation of theses</li> </ul> <p>The training is oriented to the C1 language level in the CEF (Common European Framework) and involves components of German for Specific Purposes.</p> <p><u>Goals:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Confidence in the use of subject-specific language in oral and written communication as well as in dealing with academic text types</li> <li>- Ability to analyse and interpret regional, social and cultural aspects and policies</li> </ul> <p>Completion of the module corresponds to the C1 language level in the CEF (Common European Framework).</p>
<b>Forms of Teaching</b>	<p>The form of teaching involves practical exercises (German: "Übung"= Ü) and tutorials.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ü: Fachkommunikation IV (4 teaching hours)</li> <li>• Tutorial (2 teaching hours)</li> </ul>
<b>Prerequisites for Participation</b>	B2 Certificate in the CEF (Common European Framework) or Placement Test (qualified recommendation)
<b>Applicability of the Module</b>	Suitable for all courses of studies
<b>Prerequisites for Granting Credit Points</b>	Successful passing of the module test is the prerequisite for granting credit points.
<b>Module Test</b>	<p>A module test consists of a test in which the following is accredited:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• a study project about regional, social and cultural aspects and policies (ca. 25 pages; bound)</li> <li>• a 20-minute oral test about the study project</li> </ul> <p>The student performance is granted credits if the mark of at least "sufficient" is reached.</p>
<b>Credit Points and Grades / Marks</b>	<p><b>6 credit points</b> are granted for the module. The evaluation of the test performance and the mark follow the guidelines set in §10 of the testing guidelines (Prüfungsordnung).</p> <p>A module test consists of a test in which the following is accredited:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• a study project, weighting factor: 2; passing required; (4 CP)</li> <li>• an oral test about the study project, weighting factor: 1; passing</li> </ul>

**Frequency of the Offer** The module is offered every semester.

**Amount of Work** The expected amount of work for a student to complete this module is 180 hours of work (90 hours in class and 90 hours of self-study).
