Prerequisites for Granting Credit Points	Successful passing of the module test is the prerequisite for granting credit points.
Module Test	<p>A module test consists of a test in which the following is accredited:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a 90-minute written test for Fachkommunikation I <p>The student performance is granted credits if the mark of at least "sufficient" is reached.</p>
Credit Points and Grades / Marks	4 credit points are granted for the module. The evaluation of the test performance and the mark follow the guidelines set in §10 of the testing guidelines (Prüfungsordnung).
Frequency of the Offer	The module is offered every semester.
Amount of Work	The expected amount of work for a student to complete this module is 120 hours of work (60 hours in class and 60 hours of self-study).
