Prerequisites for Granting Credit Points	Fulfilling the entrance requirements for the individual exams and the successful passing of the module test are the prerequisites for the granting of credit points.
Module Test	<p>A module test consists of the following two parts which are accredited:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a 120-minute test for course Kurs 3 • a 30-minute oral exam (presentation) for course Kurs 3 <p>The student performance is granted credits if the mark of at least "sufficient" is reached.</p>
Credit Points and Grades/Marks	<p>4 credit points are granted for the module.
