Content and Goals of the Qualification	<p><u>Content</u>: Expanding technical vocabulary in selected specific areas as well as expanding the general academic and professional vocabulary including intercultural settings. Conducting meetings and leading discussions, giving presentations including leading question-and-answer sessions, analysing and producing text-specific particularities for writing academic texts (academic essays, summaries, project descriptions, letters of motivation). The training is oriented to the language of level of C1 in the CEF (Common European Framework) and involves components of ESP (English for Specific Purposes).</p> <p><u>Goals</u>: Proficiency in oral and written exchange of information as well as in oral and written expression. This includes presentations performed according to formal criteria as well as a wide range of stylistic register in oral and written expression. Completion of the module corresponds to the language level of C1 of the CEF (Common European Framework) with an ESP (English-for-Specific-Purposes) orientation.</p>
Forms of Teaching	<p>The form of teaching involves practical exercises (German: "Übung"= Ü).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ü: Kurs 3: Advanced English in job-related situations (4 teaching hours) • Ü: Kurs 4: Scientific writing and speaking (4 teaching hours)
Prerequisites for Participation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Completion of the module Englisch in Studien- und Fachkommunikation II (Level B2) or placement test (qualified recommendation)
Applicability of the Module	Suitable for all courses of studies
Prerequisites for Granting Credit Points	<p>Fulfilling the entrance requirements for the individual exams and the successful passing of the module test are the prerequisites for the granting of credit points.</p> <p>A prerequisite is the following assignment (which can be repeated more than once):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • an academic paper (length 1,000-1,500 words, estimated at 60 hours of work) in course Kurs 4
Module Test	<p>The module test consists of a test in the following three parts which are accredited:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a 120-minute test for course Kurs 3 • a 30-minute oral exam (presentation) for course Kurs 3 • a 30-minute oral group exam for course Kurs 4 <p>The student performance is granted credits if the mark of at least "sufficient" is reached.</p>
