Completion of the module corresponds to the language level of C1 of the CEF (Common European Framework) with an ESP (English-for-Specific-Purposes) orientation.</p>

Module Test	<p>The module test consists of a test in which the following is accredited:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 30-minute oral summary of a subject-related text and a discussion of the topic within the framework of three tutorials in course Kurs 5 <p>The student performance is granted credits if the mark of at least "sufficient" is reached.</p>
Credit Points and Grades/Marks	4 credit points are granted for the module. The evaluation of the test performance and the mark follow the guidelines set in § 10 of the testing guidelines (Prüfungsordnung).
Frequency of the Offer	The module is offered every semester.
