Content and Goals of the Qualification

<u>Content</u>: Conveying advanced knowledge and skills in the academic and technical use of the English language with a focus on the linguistic and stylistic aspects of a technical environment.

The training is oriented to the language of level of C1 in the CEF (Common European Framework) and involves components of ESP (English for Specific Purposes).

<u>Goals</u>: Becoming proficient and professional in the use of English as a language of science; training and expanding communicative and interactive skills; confidence in presentations performed according to formal criteria; attaining a range of stylistic variety in oral and written expression.

Completion of the module corresponds to the language level of C1 of the CEF (Common European Framework) with an ESP (English-for-Specific-Purposes) orientation.

Forms of Teaching

The form of teaching involves practical exercises (German: "Übung" = Ü).

Prerequisites for Participation

Applicability of the Module

Suitable for all courses of studies

Prerequisites for Granting Credit Points

Fulfilling the entrance requirements for the individual exams and the successful passing of the module test are the prerequisites for the granting of credit points.

A prerequisite is the following assignment (which can be repeated more than once):

 an academic paper (length 1,000-1,500 words, estimated at 60 hours of work) in course Kurs 4

Module Test

The module test consists of a test in which the following is accredited:

• a 30-minute oral group exam for course Kurs 4

The student performance is granted credits if the mark of at least "sufficient" is reached.

Credit Points and Grades/Marks

4 credit points are granted for the module. The evaluation of the test performance and the mark follow the guidelines set in §10 of the testing guidelines (Prüfungsordnung).

Frequency of the Offer

The module is offered every semester.

Amount of Work

The module consists of a total amount of work on the part of the student of 120 hours of work (60 hours in class and 60 hours of self-study).

Length of the Module

The module normally takes one semester to complete.
