<b>Applicability of the Module</b>	Suitable for all courses of studies
<b>Prerequisites for Granting Credit Points</b>	Successful passing of the module test is the prerequisite for granting credit points.
<b>Module Test</b>	<p>A module test consists of a test in which the following is accredited:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• a 90-minute written test for Kurs 6</li> </ul> <p>The student performance is granted credits if the mark of at least "sufficient" is reached.</p>
