<b>Content and Goals of the Qualification</b>	<p><u>Content:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Consolidating and expanding language skills, overview of the entire range of forms of the target language</li> <li>- Acquiring and consolidating basic vocabulary referring to situations involving studies and professions, art, environment, social and business life</li> <li>- Special national and cultural aspects</li> <li>- Grammatical structures: passive voice with agent, participles, time frames, simple and compound superlatives, direct and reported speech, special aspects of syntax</li> <li>- Communication structures: presenting and discussing opinions / preferences of others, presenting and discussing survey findings,</li> <li>- Presenting and assessing different contributions, events and projects</li> <li>- Discussing different lifestyles</li> </ul> <p>The training is oriented to the B1 language level in the CEF (Common European Framework).</p> <p><u>Goals:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Coherent oral and written expression of one's opinion about personal areas of interest and familiar topics</li> <li>- Complex expression of hopes and goals as well as giving reasons and explanations</li> </ul> <p>Completion of the module corresponds to the B1 language level in the CEF (Common European Framework).</p>
<b>Forms of Teaching</b>	<p>The form of teaching involves practical exercises (German: "Übung"= Ü).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ü: Kurs 4 (4 teaching hours)</li> </ul>
<b>Prerequisites for Participation</b>	<p>Course 3 Certificate or Placement Test (qualified recommendation)</p> <p>The languages used in class are German and Russian. A sufficient level of German is required for participation in this course.</p>
<b>Applicability of the Module</b>	Suitable for all courses of studies
<b>Prerequisites for Granting Credit Points</b>	Successful passing of the module test is the prerequisite for granting credit points.
<b>Module Test</b>	<p>A module test consists of a test in which the following is accredited:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• a 90-minute written test for Kurs 4 (Exam number: 91504)</li> </ul> <p>The student performance is granted credits if the mark of at least "sufficient" is reached.</p>
<b>Credit Points and Grades / Marks</b>	<b>4 credit points</b> are granted for the module. The evaluation of the test performance and the mark follow the guidelines set in §10 of the testing guidelines (Prüfungsordnung).

<b>Frequency of the Offer</b>	The module is offered every semester.
<b>Amount of Work</b>	The expected amount of time for a student to complete this module is 120 hours of work (60 hours in class and 60 hours of self-study).
