<b>Content and Goals of the Qualification</b>	<p><u>Content:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Imparting basic knowledge of the Czech language (lexis, grammar, syntax) as well as of national and cultural aspects</li> <li>- Introducing and practising vocabulary referring to simple topics such as such as family and friends, knowledge of foreign languages, daily routines, eating habits, free-time activities, place of residence / accommodation</li> <li>- Grammatical structures: declension of nouns, conjugation of verbs, tenses (present and past), personal pronouns, the negative</li> <li>- Communication patterns: introducing and describing oneself and others, inquiring about prices, asking the time, ordering meals at a restaurant, talking about the past</li> </ul> <p>The training is oriented to the A1 language level in the CEF (Common European Framework).</p> <p><u>Goals:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Comprehension and use of familiar every-day expressions and simple sentences</li> <li>- Answering simple questions about personal details, family and free-time activities</li> </ul> <p>Completion of the module corresponds to the A1 language level in the CEF (Common European Framework).</p>
<b>Forms of Teaching</b>	<p>The form of teaching involves practical exercises (German: "Übung" = Ü).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ü: Kurs 1 (4 teaching hours)</li> </ul>
<b>Prerequisites for Participation</b>	The languages used in class are German and Czech. A sufficient level of German is required for participation in this course.
<b>Applicability of the Module</b>	Suitable for all courses of studies
<b>Prerequisites for Granting Credit Points</b>	Successful passing of the module test is the prerequisite for granting credit points.
<b>Module Test</b>	<p>A module test consists of a test in which the following is accredited:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• a 90-minute written test for Kurs 1 (Exam number: 92001)</li> </ul> <p>The student performance is granted credits if the mark of at least "sufficient" is reached.</p>
<b>Credit Points and Grades/Marks</b>	<b>4 credit points</b> are granted for the module. The evaluation of the test performance and the mark follow the guidelines set in §10 of the testing guidelines (Prüfungsordnung).
<b>Frequency of the Offer</b>	The module is offered every semester.
<b>Amount of Work</b>	The expected amount of time for a student to complete this module is 120 hours of work (60 hours in class and 60 hours of self-study).

<b>Length of the Module</b>	The module normally takes one semester to complete.
