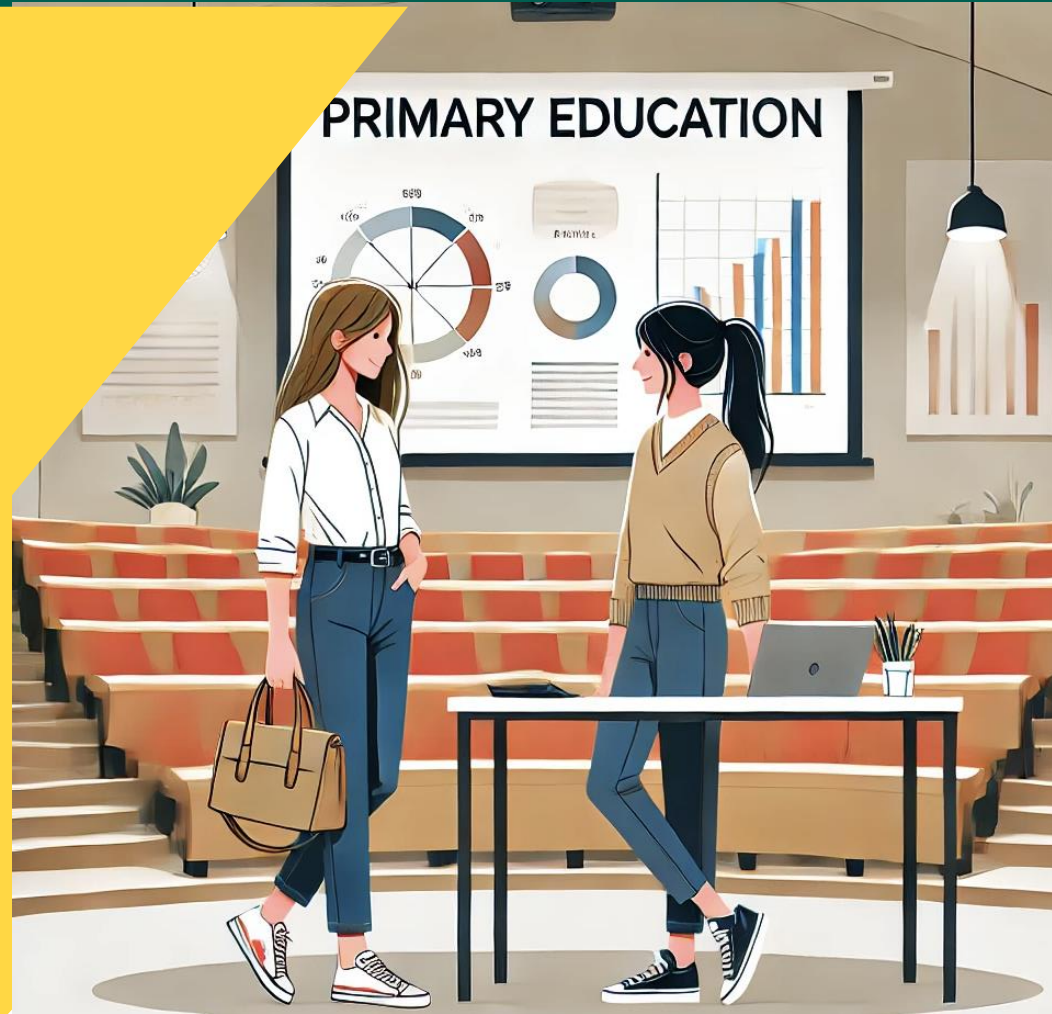


# Dialogue forum: “Innovative Primary Schools” – Making Chemnitz’s School Landscape Visible:
