

How may I register at the University Library?



- By your student identity card ("TUCcard")
- Let it "activate" at the lending desk (1st level) (bring your identity card with you!)





Activation of user account

What is the user account and where may I find it?



- By registration an online-"user account" is activated
- It may be accessed i.a. via the homepage of the Library resp. via the online catalog







Log in user account

How may I log in my user account?



- You log in your user account by:
 - user number (on your TUCcard)
 - password (by default date of birth DDMMYY, may/ should be individualized in the user account)





Search for media

How may I find media required (book, journal etc.)?



- Via the <u>online-catalog</u> of the University Library
 - simple search: entry of search term(s) in "search slot"
 - advanced search: search according to specific parameters (i.a. title, author)








Search for electronic media

Go to "Refine my Results" (left bar), tick "Online Resources"/ "Open Access"






Search for printed media




Access to electronic media

How may I get access to electronic media (e-books, e-journals)?




Click on the title-hyperlink of the elaborate required


Call numbers: open shelves versus closed stacks

What is the difference between open shelves and closed stacks with regard to printed media?



- Open shelves = is situated in openly accessible shelves (ground floor – 3rd level)
 - available for loan: may be borrowed and taken at home
 - non-circulating/ in Library use only: may exclusively being used on-site (copying/ scanning by devices on-site generally allowed)

- Closed stacks = is situated in non-openly accessible shelves
 - is provided by Library staff member on online-order
 - may be collected at the lending desk (1st level) on the next opening day in general




Order of printed media

Click on the title-hyperlink of the elaborate required



- Open shelves = submit an online-order or take it from the shelves (observe call number!) and borrow at lending desk/ at self-checkout stations (1st level)
- Closed stacks = submit an online-order and collect at the lending desk (1st level) in general on the next opening day





Delays/ charges for borrowing printed media

For how long may I borrow printed media from the collections of the University Library? Is it charged?



- Borrowing/ usage of media from the collections of the University Library is free of charges.
- Lending delay: 4 weeks (precondition: "Available for Loan")
- Lending extendable (in case of no reservation submitted by other user)

Challenges/ solutions access to electronic media

What may I do if I do not get access to an electronic medium required?



 In case that you are accessing from beyond Chemnitz University of Technology: Check whether you have downloaded and activated the <u>VPN-Client</u>.




Challenges/ solutions access to printed media

What may I do if the printed medium required is already borrowed?



 You may submit a reservation online and collect the medium subsequent to expiry of lending delay (you will receive a respective notice via email)






Challenges/ solution media not belonging to the collections

What may I do if the medium required does not belong to the collections of the University Library?



- You may order the medium required by "interlibrary loan"
 - fill in the online interlibrary loan request form
 - charges per request: 1.50 Euro
 - delay of delivery: up to 10 working days (notice via email)
 - lending delay: is determined by the lending library (the University Library has no influence on it!)
