Open Access (OA)

Open Access was initiated in 2002 by the "Budapest Open Access Initiative" (BOAI).

Since 2003 the "Berlin Declaration on Open Access to Knowledge in the Sciences and Humanities" pointed out the meaning of OA for cultural heritage and reusability of knowledge.

Open Access is supported by main funding organizations including the Deutsche Forschungsgemeinschaft (DFG) and the European Commission.

Open Access enables unrestricted online access to scientific publications worldwide without reader's fees.

It offers two main publishing models: the green road and the golden road.

Green Open Access means, you upload a copy of your manuscript to our institutional repository MONARCH-Qucosa or to any other subject repository for self-archiving. It becomes freely available after the publisher's embargo period.

Gold Open Access means free availability of your scientific manuscript (book or paper) immediately on its first publication.

University Library negotiated for you special agreements with some publishers.

Open Access Policy of the Technische Universität Chemnitz

The President of the Technische Universität Chemnitz has signed the "Berlin Declaration on Open Access to Knowledge in the Sciences and Humanities" and the Open Access Policy of the Technische Universität Chemnitz. According to this policy, it is recommended that members of the university publish Open Access.

University Library offers professional OA consulting and publishing service.


