Could the publication costs for open access publications in principle be funded by the publishing fund of the Technische Universität Chemnitz?

1	You are a member of the TU Chemnitz and "submitting or corresponding author" who is responsible for the payment of the publication fee.	<input type="checkbox"/>
2	The paper was not published as a part of third party funded project with own publishing budget.	<input type="checkbox"/>
3	The article is published in a purely open access journal with peer review process . The Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ) references such journals. Further information about quality of open access journals and publishers you will find in our Wiki .	<input type="checkbox"/>
4	The publication cost shall be no higher than 2000 Euro per article. This amount includes all costs incl. VAT! Neither publication costs higher than 2.000 Euro. Also a proportional funding is not possible in this case.	<input type="checkbox"/>
5	Open access options in otherwise subscription-based journals with hybrid model, like „Open Choice“ from Springer Online, cannot be funded.	<input type="checkbox"/>
6	Every funded publication should contain the hint: "The publication costs of this article were funded by the German Research Foundation/DFG and the Technische Universität Chemnitz in the funding programme Open Access Publishing"	<input type="checkbox"/>
7	All funded articles will be provided open access on MONARCH-Qucosa , the repository of the Technischen Universität Chemnitz.	<input type="checkbox"/>
8	Please consider the invoice notes for publication abroad .	<input type="checkbox"/>
