



Layout specifications and guidelines for writing theses at the Chair of Microeconomics

The following specifications and guidelines apply:

- The thesis should be written with 1.5 line spacing and in font size 11pt or 12pt.
- The margins should be a total of 5cm on the right and left and at least 2cm each.
- For the number of pages of the thesis the guideline from the examination regulations of the respective course applies.
- The title page should contain the following information:
 - Name of the university, optionally with the logo of the university
 - Name of the faculty and the chair (Faculty of Economics and Business Administration, Chair of Microeconomics)
 - Title of the thesis
 - Type of thesis (Bachelor's or Master's thesis)
 - First and last name, matriculation number, date of birth and course of study of the student
 - Name of first examiner (Prof. Dr. Torsten Heinrich)
 - Name of second examiner
 - Name of supervisor
 - Date of submission
- The thesis should start with an abstract.
- The thesis can be written in English or German.
- The citation style should be a common, understandable academic citation style that is used consistently. We recommend an author-year citation.
- A signed declaration of independence must be attached at the end of the work.
- The work should be printed single-sided (not double-sided).
- Type of binding: no specifications.

Further remarks: While writing the thesis, it is the responsibility of the student to stay in contact with their supervisor.
