### Purpose of Processing and Legal Basis

The processing of your personal data is carried out for the purpose of funding (selection of eligible applications, accounting and evaluation) on the basis of the first sentence of Article 6 para. 1 a) GDPR.

### Categories of Recipients of the Personal Data

Your personal data will be transmitted to the following recipients:

- the involved administrative staff of Chemnitz University of Technology
- German Academic Exchange Service.

### Transfer to a Third Country or International Organisation

The transfer to third countries or an international organisation does not take place.

### Storage Period for Personal Data

Personal Data is stored for as long as there is a storage and proof obligation towards the third-party donor: In the event of an audit by the third-party donor, the data must be retained for a maximum of five years after the project ended. Thereafter, the data will be deleted unless there are special reasons to the contrary (in particular Article 17 para. 3 GDPR).

### Rights of the Persons Affected

You have the right to request information at any time on the personal data stored by us and assigned to you (Article 15 GDPR). In addition, you have the right to correction (Article 16 GDPR), deletion (Article 17 GDPR), limitation of processing (Article 18 GDPR), data transmission (Article 20 GDPR) and objection (Article 21 GDPR).



**Revocation**

You have the right to revoke your consent at any time. The revocation of consent does not affect the legality of the processing carried out on the basis of the consent until revocation (Article 7 para. 3 GDPR).

**The Right to Lodge a Complaint**

If you believe that processing of your data is unlawful, you have the right to complain to the Saxon Data Protection Supervisor (Article 77 GDPR).

**Obligation to Provide Personal Data**

The provision of your personal data is required for financial support within the project. There is no general obligation to provide personal data. However, in the event that information is not provided, no support will be paid under InProTUC.
